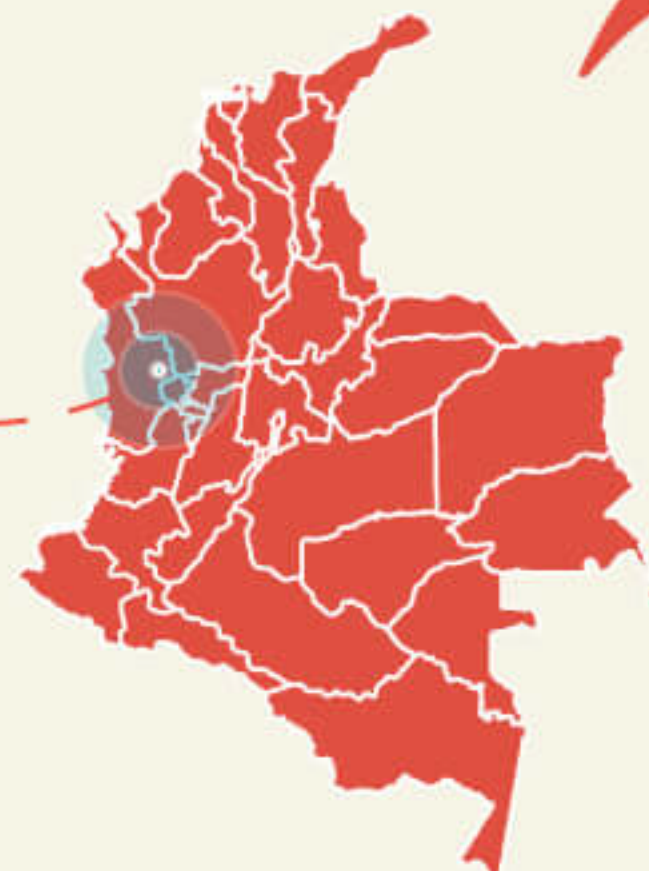
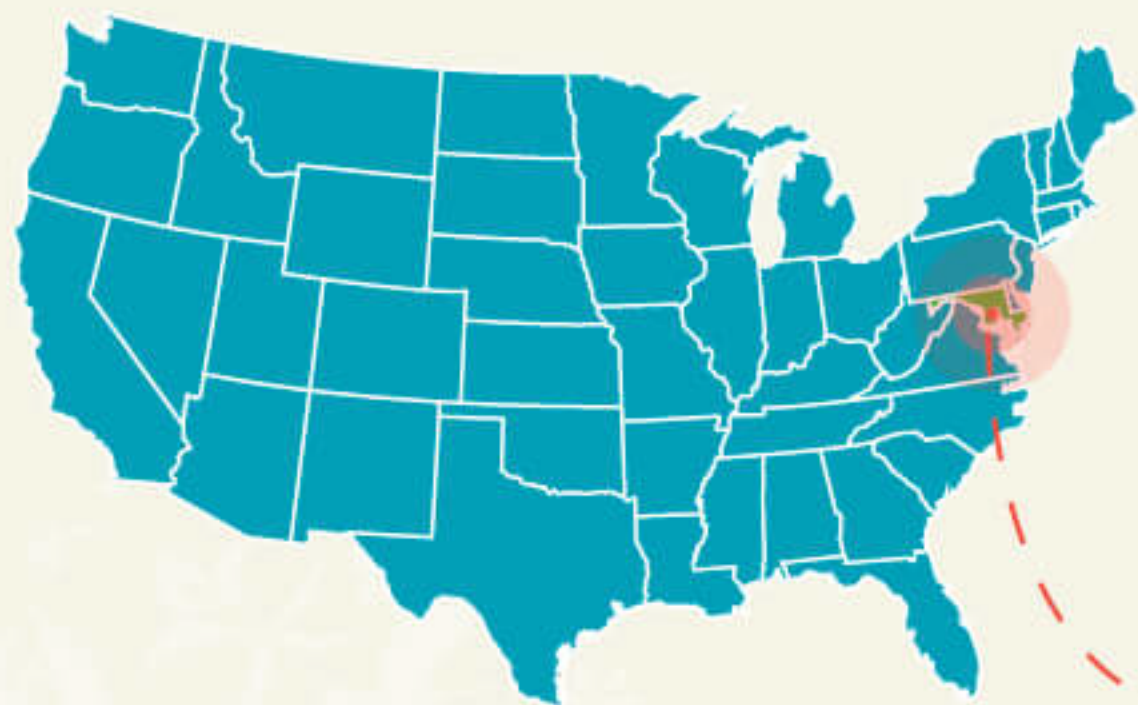
Strengthen the relations among the faculty and student body between two Universities to increase the experiential opportunities for faculty research and student engagement.
